Equipment—such as cell phone, computer, laptop, tablet and/or fax machine—related to your commission income.

However, you cannot claim things like:

Mortgage interest, Principal mortgage payments

Capital expenses like replacing windows, flooring, furnace, etc.

Deadline:

Deadline to file your tax return and pay your taxes is April 30, 2024.

If you're **self-employed** or have a spouse or a common-law partner who is self-employed, the deadline to file your taxes is **June 15, 2024**.

All tax-owing must still be paid by **April 30, 2024**.
